

# Christmas Cactus Supply List

Are you a beginning paper piecer? No worries – you'll learn the basic steps to paper piecing and be on your way to your first paper pieced quilt project! Are you an experienced paper piecer? You'll enjoy this fun project too!

## **For the BEST results and to achieve the MOST in class:**

- Please precut your fabrics per the pattern instructions (Page 1).
- Make the appropriate number of copies (16 copies of the Christmas Cactus paper piecing pattern – page 7, and 4 copies of Border A and Border B – pages 5 and 6) on the same copier. Many find that newsprint or a very thin paper works best.

## **Fabric Requirements (feel free to change up the colors to suit your preferences):**

- $\frac{3}{4}$  yard Fabric A: Green
- $\frac{3}{4}$  yard Fabric B: Light Green
- $\frac{1}{2}$  yard Fabric C: Dark Orange
- $\frac{3}{8}$  yard Fabric D: Peach
- 1 yard Fabric E: Navy
- 1 yard of backing fabric\*
- (1) 34" square piece of Warm and Natural batting\*

Christmas Cactus pattern

16 copies of the bloom paper piecing patterns (page 7)

4 copies of the Border A and Border B paper piecing patterns (page 5 and 6)

\* chances are we will NOT complete the project in class, so you will NOT need these for class, but will need them to complete the project.
