## Piecing Instructions

- 1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (4) 1 squares using an erasable marker or pencil.
- 2. Place I squares with A, C, E and G squares, right sides together. There should be (4) pairs of squares.
- 3. Sew a ¼" away from both sides of the drawn diagonal line on each square combination.
- 4. Cut along the drawn diagonal lines, making (2) A/I HST units, (2) C/I HST units, (2) E/I HST units and (2) G/I HST units. There should be (8) total HST units.
- 5. Use the following guide to trim HST units for 6" and 12" blocks:
  - a. 6" Block: 2" x 2" unfinished.
  - b. 12" Block: 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" unfinished.













## Assembly

6. Arrange the HST units and remaining cut pieces. Please note that matching prints should be placed together making (4) unique block quadrants. Sew the July block together, alternating the direction in which you press the seams in each row. Reference the Cutting Chart for unfinished block sizes.
