#### Day 1

##### Supplies

- Scraps in your chosen colors
  - Be sure to include backgrounds
  - I stuck to 3 colors in order to make the rings to stand out
  - I will bring several bags of scraps that you are free to use
- Abandoned blocks (liked the fabric, but they didn't work out)
- Sewing machine in working order
- Extra needles
- Piecing thread
- Scissors
- Pins

##### Sewing

- How to construct "made fabric"
- Have fun ... don't think too much

##### Samples

- We will cut some sample blocks, so changes can be made before going full speed ahead

##### Homework

- Make as many approximately 10" or more pieces of made fabric as you can

#### Day 2

- Continue to make your fabric
- Cutting into Wedding Ring parts
- A quick review on piecing a Wedding Ring quilt
- I am bringing three design walls that we will hang for your use. We will put on the guild quilt racks. If you have a design wall, bring it to hang over doors.

NOTE: Donna would like you to also bring a piece of fleece or batting, or a flannel-backed tablecloth that is 60" x 60" or at least 54" x 60".
